BUDAPEST – GATEWAY TO A GLORIOUS HERITAGE

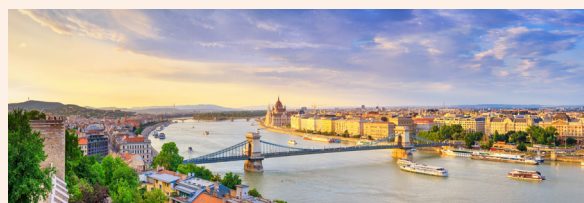
Arrive in Budapest, one of Europe's most beautiful and historically significant Jewish centers.

THE GREAT RABBANIM OF HUNGARY, SLOVAKIA & AUSTRIA

Begin the day with Shacharis in the historic Kazinczy Synagogue, one of Europe's most beautiful and distinguished batei knesses.

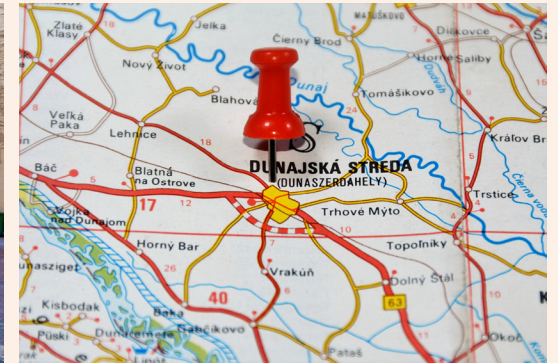
Travel to Dunajská Streda and stand at the kever of the renowned gaon, Rav Yehuda Assad, whose influence shaped generations of Torah scholarship throughout Hungary and beyond. Visit the historic shul and reflect upon the remarkable legacy of this towering Torah figure.

Continue onward to Eisenstadt, one of the most important Jewish communities of Austria, where we visit the kever and shul of the holy Panim Meiros, one of the most celebrated poskim of his era.

Later, fly onward to Poland, where a new chapter of our journey begins.

As evening approaches, arrive in Alexander and visit the sacred kevarim of the Alexander Rebbes, whose dynasty became one of the largest and most influential Chassidic movements in pre-war Europe.

FOLLOWING THE FOOTSTEPS OF GIANTS

Today is devoted to some of the most remarkable Torah personalities of Poland.

Visit the kever of Rav Eliyahu Chaim Meisel, beloved Rav of Lodz and one of the most respected communal leaders of his generation.

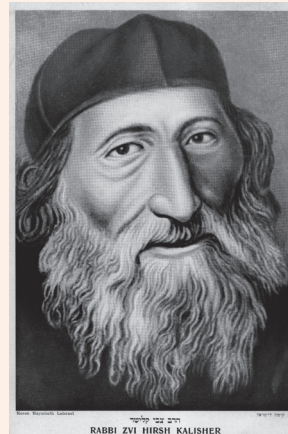
Continue to Kalisz, where we stand at the resting place of the holy Magen Avraham, whose sefer remains an indispensable cornerstone of halachic study in every beis medrash around the world.

Travel onward to Ostrow and visit the kever of Rav Yechiel Mier, preserving the memory of another vibrant center of Torah life that once flourished in Poland.

Later, arrive in Toruń, where we commemorate the legacy of Rav Tzvi Hirsch Kalischer, one of the great visionaries of nineteenth-century Torah leadership.

As night falls, we arrive in Poznań for a profoundly moving visit to the kever of the legendary Rav Akiva Eiger, whose brilliance, humility, and Torah scholarship continue to illuminate the Jewish world to this very day.
