

FLY TO SYDNEY

- » Tour of Sydney We start at the beginning of the European Settlement here; The Rocks, the oldest heritage listed part of Sydney, where you will be entertained with colourful stories of Jews on the First Fleet. I will show you where the first Jewish shops and businesses began and you will get to know about some of the famous convicts. You will hear the story of Ruth Abrams, a young Jewish milliner, all of 15 years-old when she was sent here on the First Fleet.
- » The colourful Jewish peoples' stories from hundreds of years ago, live on today.
- » We visit The Sydney Jewish Museum which houses original memorabilia related to the Holocaust, Judaica and Australian Jewish History.
- » We then meander through the streets of the Eastern Suburbs, where you'll see the homes of prominent Australian Jews who have made major contributions to life in Sydney - you will learn about their rise - becoming business and philanthropic leaders, in Australia.
- » Next, we visit Central Synagogue, the largest in the Southern Hemisphere, accommodating 2500 people and it has the largest Jewish congregation in Australasia. You may even talk to the Rabbi here and play the game of Jewish Geography (6

- degrees of separation). The majestic Synagogue is a marvel of modern architecture flooded with natural lighting by an oculus in the ceiling.
- » Imported Jerusalem stone adorns the Aron Kodesh, which is positioned in a direct line with Jerusalem.
- » You'll stroll the iconic Bondi Beach. sip coffee or even lunch. We go local for kosher food as we know all the authentic haunts
- » Then we hit Hall Street, home to the Jewish Butcher, Kosher Bakery and Restaurant as well as visiting the Jewish bookstore.
- » Lastly, we take you to our secretly known spots for jaw dropping views of the breathtaking Sydney Harbour with the Harbour Bridge and Opera House as our backdrop.
- » Not another vehicle in sight, only locals walking about, you and us reflecting on Sydney's beauty, idyllic locations, Jewish family stories, sensational flavours, histories and unforgettable Jewish-style Australian journey.




TUESDAY

MORNING FLIGHT TO CHRISTCHURCH

» Begin Tour

SPRINGFIELD/ALPINE JET

» As we make our way through the Selwyn District you will be greeted by the Gorgeous little western town of Springfield where we make our turn off towards Alpine Jets. Here you will spend time experiencing the wonders of the Waimakariri, it's no wonder Jet Boating was developed here in Christchurch! For those that have decided to not add this onto their tour, there are walks, views and sheep cuddles to enjoy.

CASTLE HILL

» Once back in the bus we head towards Castle Hill. These weathered limestone rocks sit proudly on the tussocky hills and were once in the ocean! Over time they eroded away and started forming these amazing unique shapes you'll see today. You might recognize this landscape from movies such as Lord of the Rings and Narnia! That's right. Not only that, but while you walk amongst the rocks you will also see climbers and boulderers! This place is a magnet for those types of hobbies. This is not a guided walk so you will be left to explore this piece of beauty on your own.

OTIRA GORGE LOOKOUT

» Also known as Deaths Corner! The Otira Viaduct Lookout is an amazing spot to see the national park in all its glory. This bridge is the only reason

driving Arthurs Pass is possible! It's huge at 440 Meters long and is a great spot for a photo of the bridge and the surrounding landscape. A little bonus too, you might see a wee Cheeky Kea! The sneaky Alpine Parrot of NZ.

ARTHURS PASS VILLAGE

» We depart the lookout and head towards Arthur's Pass village. On the way you will be able to see the beautiful backdrop of the majestic Southern Alps up close. Once we arrive you will have the opportunity to either walk the Devils Punch Bowl or spend this time walking around the local shop.

DEVILS PUNCH BOWL

» This walking track is approx. 1 hour with a gradual incline including steps towards a ferocious 131-meter-tall waterfall. Fitness is low to moderate as you walk through the bush and forest.

ARTHURS PASS VILLAGE

» This village is a great way to really get to know the area.

TRANZALPINE

» Our guide will drop you at the Train Station to continue your journey back towards the Canterbury Plains, via the TranzAlpine.

AUCKLAND HARBOUR BRIDGE

- » The Auckland Harbour Bridge spans Waitemata Harbour, connecting the Central City with the North Shore City. It stands as Auckland's largest bridge and plays a vital role in the city's infrastructure. Meet the unique extension of the Harbour Bridge, and New Zealand's largest Yacht Marina.
- » Westhaven Marina Westhaven Marina in Auckland, New Zealand, is the largest yacht marina in the Southern Hemisphere Enjoy the spectacular city view from Auckland's largest marina.

DEVONPORT

» It is the oldest town in Auckland, where you can see heritage houses and heritage buildings. We will also introduce one of the heritage houses to you.

NORTH HEAD

» The North Head Historic Reserve, situated at the entrance of Waitemata Harbour, is one of Auckland's volcanic mountain. It was transformed into a fortress in the late 1800s to defend against potential Russian invasions. Tunnels and cannons were strategically placed here as a deterrent against foreign aggression. Here you will experience entering the tunnel and come face to face with cannons made with the best technology of the time

MOUNT EDEN

» Mount Eden is Auckland's highest volcanic mountain and a beloved tourist attraction, offering panoramic views of the cityscape from its summit. Check out the panoramic view of Auckland City here.



- » Embark on a fully guided day trip to Waitomo Caves and around Rotorua, combining Nature, Maori culture, and two of the top attractions in the North Island to form the ultimate day trip from Auckland.
- » Learn along the way with stories and rich background knowledge from your experienced guide, and enjoy a tour packed with extras ensuring your comfort and safety.
- » Visit the Waitomo Glowworm Caves, famous for their population of glow worms, a species found only in New Zealand. See the glowworms, their cave habitat, and the rivers that run through the caves. Due to the delicate ecosystem within the Waitomo Caves, photography is not permitted inside. This policy helps protect the glowworms and limestone formations, ensuring the preservation of this unique environment for future visitors to enjoy.
- » Make a stop at Te Puia Geothermal Park and Pohutu Geyser, known for its bubbling mud pools, exploding geysers, and other geothermal features.
- » Experience the Maori Cultural Village and Arts School, and learn more about traditional Maori art and culture, including weaving, wood carving, and stone carving.
