- Board your return flight to Newark with your group, filled with inspiration, connection, and unforgettable memories.

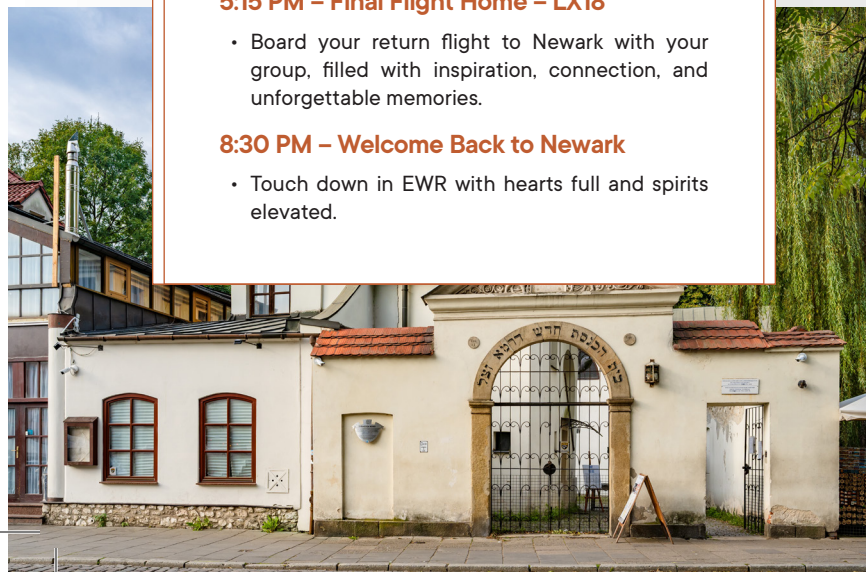

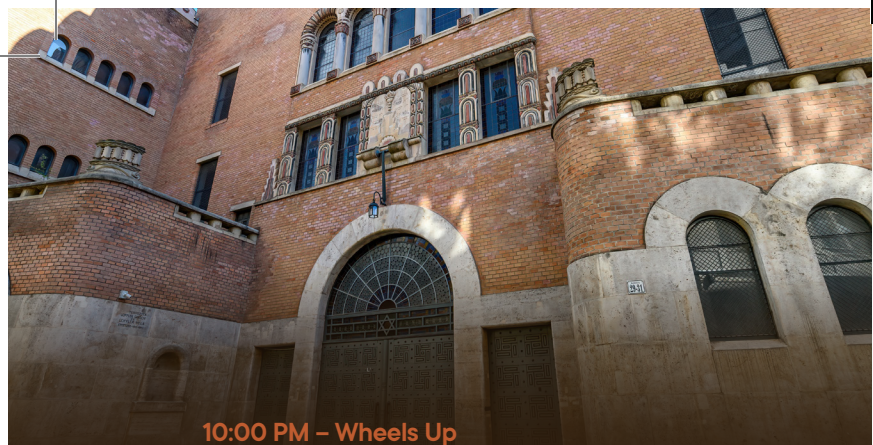

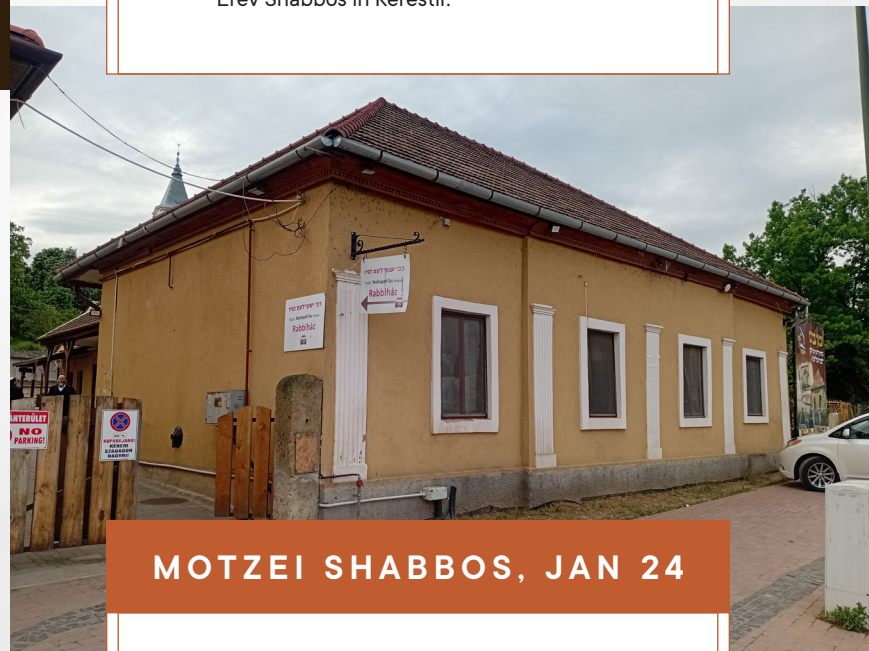
